- › Tour the Wadlata Centre
- › Set up camp
- › Travel 415kms today

- › Travel by coach into Central Australia viewing salt lakes and clay pans onto Coober Pedy
- › View an opal demonstration
- › No tents tonight, sleeping underground
- › Travel 540kms today

Day 6:

- › Depart Coober Pedy and on through Marla Bore
- › Cross the Northern Territory Boarder at Kulgera
- › Set up camp
- › Star gazing by camp fire
- › Travel 640kms today

Day 7:

- › Early rise to climb Ayers Rock
- › Visit Kata Tjuta
- › Tourist flights (optional extra, at own expense)
- › Watch the sun set at Sunset Strip
- › Stay at Ayers Rock Resort

Day 8:

- › Travel by coach to Kings Creek Station
- › Visit the Kings Canyon and have a swim
- › Set up camp at Kings Creek Station Campground

Day 9:

- › Travel by coach to Alice Springs
- › Stop for a camel ride
- › Travel through the MacDonnell Ranges
- › Afternoon to relax
- › Set up camp



Day 10:

- › In the morning visit the Alice Springs Desert Park and the School of the Air
- › View Heavitree Gap, Todd River and desert landscape
- › In the afternoon visit the Royal Flying Doctor Service and stop for photos at Anzac Hill
- › In the evening visit the Andrew Langford's 'Sounds of Starlight' theatre
- › Lunch at own expense today

- › Travel the Stuart Highway to Tennant Creek
- › Observe the Eggs of the Rainbow Serpent
- › Set up camp
- › Travel 510kms today

Day 12:

- › Head into the Tablelands and the Never Never
- › Visit Newcastle Waters Township
- › Arrive at Mataranta and set up camp
- › Travel 570kms today

Day 13:

- › Visit Nitmiluk National Park and go on a Katherine River Gorge cruise
- › Enter Kakadu National park
- › Tour the Bowali visitor centre and Yellow Water Boardwalk
- › Travel 400kms today

Day 14:

- › Another cruise today - watch out for the crocodiles!
- › Visit Litchfield National Park, featuring stunning waterfalls and wildlife
- › See some amazing termite mounds before continuing on to Darwin

- › Enjoy a city sights tour, including Parliament House
- › Visit Fanny Bay Gaol
