# What is High School Preparation?

Are you ready to learn and practise English in Queensland, Australia before progressing to your preferred high school?

Come and join our High School Preparation (HSP) program that provides encouragement, motivation and support, as well as a very high pass rate.

We offer a 20-week intensive program that is available to start at the beginning of any school term for Years 7-10 students (January, April, July and October).

If you are enrolling in Year 11, you must start the HSP program in Year 10, no later than July. This enables you to meet the 2-year Queensland Certificate of Education requirements.

The best thing is, you don't need to pass any English language tests for the HSP program but you will still need to have the English language requirements to start at your chosen enrolled high school.

You will develop English speaking, listening, reading and writing skills and then practise them in different subjects such as mathematics, science, literature, humanities and social sciences, and even while playing sport.

The HSP program is offered at 3 Brisbane schools - **Indooroopilly State High School, Whites Hill State College and Mitchelton State High School**. These schools have specialist HSP accredited teachers and staff to make your English language journey successful.

After passing the HSP program, you can then start at your enrolled high school.



## Key program facts

- 12 to 15 years (Years 7-10)
- Enrol in one of the 3 HSP Brisbane school centres where the intensive English course includes a minimum of 20 hours per week within a 25-hour school week.
- The average program time is 20-weeks (depending on your level of English) but students can enrol up to 40-weeks if they need to.
- Enjoy and experience small interactive classes.
- Build your language skills with confidence in different subjects such as mathematics, science, humanities and social sciences and literature.



## What are the benefits of HSP?

Imagine how much easier it will be to reach the level of English that you need to start high school here in Queensland. Practising your English language skills in different situations can boost your confidence and help you learn about the 'Aussie' culture with your new local friends and homestay family.

You will have access to specialist teachers and staff who are dedicated to guiding you through your English language journey while providing you with the essential academic skills you need for high school.

## When can I start?

You can start your study at the beginning of any school term for Years 7-10 in January, April, July and October.

If you will be starting at your high school for Year 11 (and then on to Year 12 to complete the 2-year Queensland Certificate of Education), you must commence HSP no later than July the previous year in Year 10 before the Year 11 term begins in January.



## How can I apply?

First, find an education agent in your home country to get advice and help you prepare your application through to enrolment. They have the knowledge and understanding to make it easier for you.

## What do you need to start HSP?

To enrol, you need to prove that you have passed all of your core subjects in your previous 2-years of schooling.

During your HSP study, you will need to participate in class activities, complete all the assessments and be successful in achieving the required levels of English for your mainstream high school program.
