As a Queensland Recognised School (QRS), you are presented with the unique opportunity to deliver the Queensland curriculum in your country.

Currently, EQI collaborates with 7 QRS across various locations including the United Arab Emirates, China, Nauru, and Taiwan, delivering Queensland's senior curriculum (Years 11 and 12).

Eligible graduates from a QRS will receive the Queensland Certificate of Education (QCE) and an Australian Tertiary Admissions Rank (ATAR). These qualifications pave the way for access to prestigious universities in Australia and around the world.

In addition to the QRS, EQI also works in partnership with Lihir International School in Papua New Guinea, where the Australian P-10 curriculum, developed by the Australian Curriculum, Assessment and Reporting Authority (ACARA), is offered.

School reviews

Reviews are part of the support provided to offshore schools. Reviews support schools on their improvement journey to deliver a world-class education for students. The Queensland Department of Education reviews all Queensland state schools and centres, as well as offshore schools once every 4 years. Reviews are conducted by experienced educators appointed by the department's Reviews and School Improvement branch.

Through meaningful engagement and input from school staff, students and communities, reviews involve the evaluation of evidence against the <u>School Improvement Tool</u>, an internationally validated framework for reviewing school-based practices that contribute to school improvement. At the completion of a review, a written report is provided to the school that details the findings and recommendations tailored to the school's context and needs.

Queensland's curriculum offshore delivery programs are for offshore schools that offer Queensland / Australian curriculum to students living outside of Australia who are considering a pathway to further studies in Australia. EQI assesses and accepts applications for schools seeking to become a QRS.

Successful applicants can then implement the Queensland's curriculum offshore delivery programs by entering into a service level agreement with EQI.



The Queensland Certificate of Education

The most highly prized qualification is the QCE which provides students with 21st century knowledge and skills, including critical thinking, creativity, communication and teamwork to prepare them for success in their work and life.

The QCE is Queensland's senior school qualification awarded to eligible students by the QCAA at the end of Year 12.

All eligible graduates also receive an ATAR score. The ATAR is well known internationally and enables entry into Australian and many of the world's highly regarded universities.


