Queensland Academies Creative Industries Campus.

Queensland Academy for Science Mathematics and Technology.

Located in Toowong, only 4km from central Brisbane, the Queensland Academy for Science Mathematics and Technology (QASMT) provides a focussed IB curriculum. Students benefit from a formal collaboration with The University of Queensland, to provide the transition between senior school and university. Students experience a stunning STEM Precinct providing contemporary learning areas, robotics and state of the art science laboratories and e-learning hubs. There is also a new Languages Precinct with uniquely designed classroom spaces and rooms for delivering the language acquisition programs in addition to university standard science laboratories throughout the whole campus. QASMT students are focussed on a university pathway and have a proven record in attaining offers to some of the most prestigious universities throughout the world.










Queensland Academies for Health Sciences Campus.

Located on the Gold Coast, Queensland Academies for Health Sciences Campus (QAHS) is co-located with Griffith University, all within the Gold Coast Health and Knowledge Precinct.

QAHS students are involved in a broad range of challenging enrichment activities - some include the Commonwealth Scientific and Industrial Research Organisation (CSIRO) CREST Research Awards, BHP Billiton Science Research Awards, regional, state and national mathematics and science competitions, regional sport, leadership development programs, Australian Business Week, language and linguistics competitions, a comprehensive instrumental music program and various community projects. They focus on local and global perspectives to broaden the view of their students place in the world.







The International Baccalaureate program attracts students from around the world and brings them together alongside our local students to study, connect and learn about different cultures.

Queensland Academies selective entry requirements.

Application to enrol is only through a selective entry application process.

An applicant must show:

- high standards of personal behaviour
- commitment to personal and social development
- a sense of citizenship displayed through care and concern for others
- successful academic results in their previous 2 years of study.

You will need to successfully undertake the Queensland Academies selective entry process - an online application, sit an entrance test, and if shortlisted, attend an interview. Places are awarded on merit.
