Does your child meet the following criteria?

- your child is now in Year 10 or Year 11 and not over the age of 18
- has studied English for two or more years
- has achieved at least General International English Language Testing System (IELTS) overall score of OP 5.0 verifiable or have another level of English proficiency accepted for entry
- their grades over the past two school years have been passes or higher in all subjects.

You understand that -

- you are enquiring about studying an Australian Senior Secondary Certificate of Education qualification and there are fees as an international student
- you have read the example living costs and have sufficient funds for your child to complete the qualification in Queensland
- your child meets the eligibility conditions for the student visa 500
- you are aware that you need to apply for your child's program and receive an enrolment agreement to be accepted into the program.
- if your child is accepted to study in a Queensland government school they (and their parent/guardian) are a genuine temporary entrant.
