Fraser Island Safari (October 2017)

Education Queensland International's Fraser Island Safari provides students with the opportunity to travel from Brisbane up the coast of Queensland to beautiful Fraser Island – the world's largest sand island with over 100 freshwater lakes and ancient rainforest surrounded by pristine white sandy beaches.

Itinerary

Day 1

- › After collecting all students we travel on our 4WD bus to Double Island Point, where you will be able to take some photos of Point Lighthouse and the coloured sands of Rainbow Beach, then onto the ferry to Fraser Island.
- › First stop is 75 Mile Eastern Surf Beach, then a swim at Lake Wabby. Here you may spot turtles and fish in Fraser Islands deepest lake.
- › In the evening you will enjoy a beach walk and nature trails before a BBQ dinner, campfire and outdoor entertainment.

Day 2

- › Travel to Eli Creek, enjoy floating down the fastest flowing creek on the Island, marvel at the coloured sand formation at The Pinnacles. Photo opportunity at the famous Maheno Shipwreck.
- › Continue along 75 Mile Beach to Champagne Pools for a refreshing swim, climb Indian Head to see magnificent views, where you may spot a shark or turtle.
- › Return to camp and explore some of the many nature walks before an evening meal.

- › Early rise to watch the sunrise over the ocean, or enjoy a nature walk before breakfast.
- › Swim, hike and take lots of photographs of the beach and wildlife.
- › Visit Lake Mackenzie then head to Wangoolba Creek to enjoy a boardwalk, see giant King Ferns and the world heritage satinay forest.
- › Return to Rainbow Beach via Hook Point (lunch is at own expense).
- › Take the ferry home, arriving at Noosa 3pm, Caloundra 5pm and Brisbane 7pm.
