Itinerary

Day 1

- › Fly from Brisbane to Sydney to start your adventure, where our coach will take you to the Blue Mountains.
- › Travel towards Katoomba and visit the Three Sisters.
- › Enjoy a ride on the Scenic Railway to the valley floor and take your time and explore the Jurassic rainforest on the Scenic Walkway, before travelling back to the top of the valley on the Scenic Cableway.

Day 2

- › Take a short drive to Jenolan Caves and explore the Chifley cave, an amazing treasure trove of caves featuring large chambers richly draped in colourful limestone crystal.
- › Travel to Blackheath and meet an Aboriginal Discovery Ranger for a guided bushwalk. Your Ranger will share

their knowledge of various foods and medicines in the woodland, the tour ending at Govetts Leap Lookout with breathtaking views across the Grose Wilderness.

- › Tour the town of Katoomba where there will be time to explore some of the quaint shops and cafes before dinner.

Day 3

- › Travel down the highway towards the Nation's Capital Canberra, where your first stop is the Illawarra Fly Tree Top Walk.
- › Walk through rainforest and the steel treetop walk, 20 – 30 metres above ground with breathtaking views over the Illawarra.

- › After lunch we enjoy a bushwalk before continuing on, arriving late afternoon in Canberra.
- › Explore the city and the many shops, cafes and restaurants before heading to our accommodation early evening.

Day 4

- › Visit the Australian Institute of Sport and enjoy a guided tour of the centre, where Australia's top athletes train in top class surroundings.
- › Drive around the overseas Embassies and High Commissions that maintain their country's diplomatic relationships with Australia followed by a self guided tour of the Federal Parliament building.
- › Visit the Australian War Memorial and explore the many exhibits before watching the Last Post – a moving ceremony to honour the many lives lost.

Day 5

- › Travel north to Sydney, arriving mid morning.
- › First stop is Bronte Beach where you will take coastal walk to Bondi Beach.
- › In the afternoon visit Watsons Bay for a walk up to the Edge, to see stunning views across to Manly.
- › Return to the city where there is time explore Paddy's Markets, to purchase souvenirs for family and friends.

Day 6

- › See Sydney Harbour from the best vantage point – walking the Bridge Climb. Absorb a 360 degree panorama of Sydney as you journey to the summit of the bridge.
- › At the summit have a group photography, before descending this magnificent bridge. You will receive a group photograph, BridgeClimb cap and certificate of achievement.
- › Visit the Pylon Lookout and learn about the history of this fascinating structure.
- › Walk around the Opera House, the Botanical Gardens and the Rocks, one of Sydney's oldest areas.
