## Day 2

- › Take a short drive to Jenolan Caves and explore the Chifley cave, an amazing treasure trove of caves featuring large chambers richly draped in colourful limestone crystal.
- › Travel back to Katoomba and visit the Three Sisters.
- › Enjoy a ride on the Scenic Railway down to the valley floor and explore the Jurassic rainforest on the Scenic Walkway, before travelling back to the top of the valley on the Scenic Cableway.
