

# Temporary Residents Admissions Centre Fee Structure & Exemption Criteria



## Fees and Payment

Most students holding temporary resident visas are required to pay fees to attend a Queensland state school.

Tuition fees must be paid in advance and are calculated based on the number of weeks of the enrolment (enrolment for part of a week incurs the charge for a full week). Fees are paid whether or not the student actually attends during the period of enrolment.

Tuition fees are subject to change, are reviewed on an annual basis and usually increase each year in line with the Government Indexation Rate. Applicants will be required to pay the adjusted fees from the date of implementation. All fees must be paid in Australian dollars and are inclusive of GST (if applicable).

A Temporary Residents Admission Centre (TRAC) Authority to Enrol is issued after TRAC has received payment for fees.

## Dependent Students Enrolment Fee Structure

Fees are paid annually in advance.

## Fee exemption

School aged dependants of temporary visa holders may be eligible for an exemption from paying international student school tuition fees in Queensland state schools. ## Tourist Visa Enrolment Fee Structure

Fees for the duration of the enrolment are paid in advance.

The minimum period of enrolment is 2 weeks. Students on tourist visas cannot study for more than 3 months unless permitted by the Department of Home Affairs. Once the initial application has been processed, extensions may only be considered by Education Queensland International in extenuating circumstances.

## Bridging Visa Enrolment Structure

Fees are calculated based on the substantive visa of the applicant (see above) and are paid, in advance, on a term by term basis.
